### INTRODUCTION

With the Address Importer you will be able to import contacts from Hotmail, Gmail, MSN and Yahoo! Contacts List. The functionality of the Address Importer can be found on [Multiply.com](http://Multiply.com), [Ringo.com](http://Ringo.com) and [MySpace.com](http://MySpace.com). With the Address Importer anyone can have the same functionality in just minutes..

The AddressImporter consists of 3 classes. This allows you to easily integrate the Address Importer with your own PHP scripts. The AddressImporter will ask the user for his/her email address and password which will then contact the specific service to retrieve their address book. The result can be used to send invitations or any other marketing purpose.

This package contains the official code loaded example without the restriction.

### REQUIREMENTS

To run the Address Importer from your webserver, you will need to have the following programs and or modules installed:

- PHP4
- The curl library installed

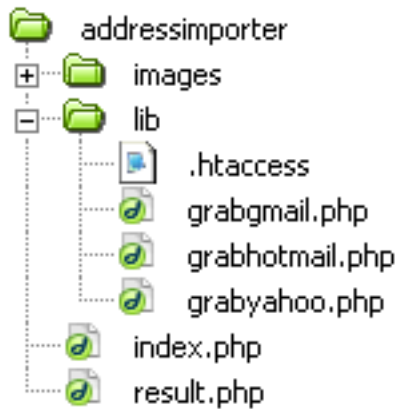

## INSTALLING

### INSTALLING

Installing our demo script is very easy. Just unzip the package to a folder on your webserver. This folder will need to have read and write access. So make sure to chmod the folder to 777.

Once you have completed this the tree structure will look like this:



The demo will now fully function.

### MODIFYING

This demo returns the email addresses in an array. This array is found in result.php and is called \$returned\_emails. This array is a basic array where every row contains an email address.

This array can be looped through by using a foreach function. With a foreach function you can easily extract the email addresses from the array for further usage. For instance: you can insert the email addresses in a database or you can integrate it with a mail-sending script.
